## September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 MEETING

Meeting called to order at 7:00PM **Roll call of officers**: All present

Motion to post Meeting Notes on the club website was passed by a majority vote.

Bills: Bills presented and passed by committee.

Conservation/Stocking: No new business.

**Scholarship:** No new business. **Legislative:** No new business.

By-Laws: Changes to the By-laws will be discussed at the next e-board meeting.

The change in price for Family Memberships to be raised to \$150.00 to take effect in 2017 was voted upon and passed by a majority vote.

The proposed approval to spend an additional \$300.00 (on top of an already approved \$560.00) on six (6) 6ft Heavy Duty Picnic Tables was voted upon and passed by majority vote.

Made a motion to except Seth McCoy and his team, for plowing this year. It will cost \$4680.00 for the Sanford Range and the Club House. Motion was voted upon and passed by a majority vote.

**Acton Fair:** Went quite well even though the fair itself was slow, and have made money so far. Thank you to the volunteers who came and helped.

**Gun Show:** September 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> at the Sanford Armory. Set-up is on the 15<sup>th</sup>.

Because the Sanford Armory will be undergoing Renovations after the September Gun Show, the Club will not be able to rent the building for one (1) year until the renovations are complete. The club will be looking for a new venue to hold the next two gun shows.

**Hunter Safety:** The Schedule has been put together; there will be two (2) classes;

Building: No new business.

**Sanford Range**: Thank you for the help with the Stone Dust.

Bruce has a few pictures of a man and woman shooting a shotgun at the 1<sup>st</sup> Rifle Range, but has not been able to identify the individuals.

**Berwick Range:** The Berwick Range will be closed starting on Tues. Sept. 6<sup>th</sup> for the State Match.

The steel plates are moved off to the side along the berm for STORAGE, and need to be moved to shoot at.

Resetting ropes are for the steel plates are locked in the storage shed. May be able to make an outside box into a lockable box.

The one at Country Pond will be on Halloween, it will be a costume shoot where if you don't show up in costume, you can't shoot.

**Archery:** Saturday Aug. 3<sup>rd</sup> will be Pick-Up and 6:30.

Junior Archery: No new business. Range Safety: No new business.

**Elections of Motions:** No new business.

**Unfinished Business:** Family Membership; It was proposed that we raise the Family Membership (Husband and Wife) to \$150.00, and keep the Single Membership at \$100.00. These changes will not be effective until the renewal of Dues in 2017. The change in price for Family Memberships to be raised to \$150.00 to take effect in 2017 was voted upon and passed by a majority vote.

<u>Picnic Tables</u>; Researched the pricing for some new picnic tables. Looked at a 6ft Spruce and Pressure Treated Lumber table. There are two kinds; Standard and Heavy Duty. Pricing for 6ft Standard Table is \$129.00, and an 8ft Standard Table is \$159.00. Pricing for a 6ft Heavy Duty Table is \$189.00, and an 8ft Heavy Duty Table is in-between \$279-289.

The Club already "OK" \$560.00 for new picnic tables. If they ordered six (6) 6ft Heavy Duty Tables, it would only cost \$300 more. Also, the club can order them now, and have them delivered in the Spring. The proposed approval to spend an additional \$300.00 on six (6) 6ft Heavy Duty Picnic Tables was voted upon and passed by majority vote.

<u>New Locks</u>; Bruce has the new locks, but will not install them until the Alarm Codes have been changed. **New Business**:

Plate Shoot; No set date yet, but it will be held at the Berwick Range. Keep an eye out on the Website.

<u>Cowboy Town</u>; Members can go down and shoot there, but if you take out anything to use, then please put it away when you're done.
